




- ❖ Period of collaboration (1.978/2012)
 - Participation in the different Spanish governments
- Historical references (part 1):
 - 01.932 First "Estatut" was born.
 - $\circ 1.938$ After the Civil War, "Estatut" was repealed by Franco.
 - 01.640/1.873/1.931/1.934 Historical years where the existence of independence in Catalonia is argued.

- Historical references (part 2):
 - o 1.714 Succession War.
 - September 11: "LA DIADA".
 - o Period 1.978-2.012 Dialogue and cooperation.

- Historical references (part 3)
 - Catalonia highest levels of self-government
 - oJune, 18/2006 New ESTATUT was approved.
 - June 20/2.010, 14 articles of new Estatut were declared unconstitutional.

2.2.- Catalonia (5/12)

- Transformation to independent thesis [2.012-2.017]:
 - Financing problems.
 - Unconstitutionality of new "Estatut".
 - Deficit in infrastructure investments in Catalonia.
 - Catalonia around the 30% of Spanish GDP.

2.2.- Catalonia (6/12)

- *Transformation to independent thesis [2.012-2.017]:
 - Fiscal deficit.
 - Insufficient returns/contribution.
 - o Territory with an industrial tradition.

2.2.- Catalonia (7/12)

- Transformation to independent thesis [2.012-2.017]:
 - Deficit in infrastructures investments.
 - Non recognition of the new "Estatut".
 - 2.012/2.017 period of no dialogue, passivity of the Spanish government.
 - o Moderate Catalan politicians transform to independent ideas.

2.2.- Catalonia (8/12)

*Population:

- Catalonia around 7,5 million people.
- Period 1.978/2.012 around 30% of population feels really Catalan.
- Sentence "Madrid steals us".

2.2.- Catalonia (9/12)

*Population:

- After 2.012 up to day independence citizens grow to 48%.
- o Great division of the population in Catalonia.
- Intervention of the powers of the autonomy/ autonomic elections.

2.2.- Catalonia (10/12)

*****CONCLUSIONS:

- Catalonian government support is only the 48%
- The unilateral way to reach the independence.
- Division of the citizens: the 50% is against the independence movement.
- Slowdown in the growth of the economy.

2.2.- Catalonia (11/12)

***CONCLUSIONS:**

- Exit of companies from the Catalan territory due to the conflict.
- Elections.
- This situation must end.
- $_{\odot}$ With the support of only the 50% of the population, the independence cannot be achieved in Catalonia.


2.2.- Catalonia (12/12)
