Myths of U.S. Taxation

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US LLCs pay no US tax.

I don't pay any tax in the US if I have a student or diplomatic visa.

I am never in the U.S. more than 150 days. I can claim I am not a U.S. tax resident since I live in Panama and my businesses are in Argentina.

I received a green card on Dec. 12, 2009. I can give up my green card on Dec. 11, 2017 or even earlier on Jan. 12, 2016 and I have no tax to pay on leaving the U.S.

My company exports to the US. Product is delivered to buyer in US. We have no office or employees in the US. We are not subject to US tax.
